
'AUCKLAND MATTERS'

LISTENING FOR AND HEARING GOD'S VOICE

We can listen to God speak to us by...

Good Reading (of God's Word)

If we give ourselves to regular, systematic enjoyment of the Bible, even just a bit each day, God feeds and speaks to us.

Good Listening

- > We need to talk and pray to God regularly.
- ➤ It takes time, but as we develop into a relationship with God, we begin to recognise the voice of the Holy Spirit in our heart.
- > God will sometimes speak through giving us a strong desire to do something.

Good Reasoning

- > God has given every human being a conscience.
- God has also given us minds to think and to reason. Thinking and God guiding us often go together.
- ▶ In the big decisions and the small, our common sense is very important.

Good Advice

- ➤ It's not only what is God saying to me: each of us needs to have the humility to recognise that God also speaks to other people, and has done so for thousands of years.
- > We can ask advice of another Christian we trust at church

seven questions to Help Answer... But is it really God speaking to me?
- seven very simple questions that you can ask yourself
regarding each possible solution or each possible answer.

- Is it consistent with the Word of God? Does it fit the principles that are in the Bible?
- 2. **Is it a wise decision?** In your own heart and mind, is it the type of solution that Jesus Christ himself would agree with and implement?
- 3. Are you confident in asking God to enable you to achieve this solution? Can you look upon this solution as one that God would send into your life?
- 4. **Do you feel that it is a God-given solution?** Deep within your heart do you feel or sense that this solution is the will of God?
- 5. **Does this solution fit a child of God?** From all that you know about God, does this solution or this answer fit a person who truly loves, believes and trusts God?
- 6. **Does this solution fit God's overall plan for your life?** Does this solution fir in with God's guidance and direction for your life?
- 7. **Does this solution honour God?** Does it bring glory and praise to Almighty God?
