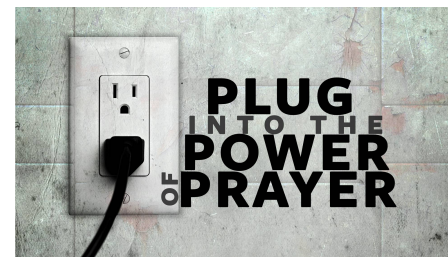

Anzac biscuits for our neighbours

Monday April 24 we will take ANZAC biscuits to our neighbours to commemorate ANZAC Day on April 25. ANZAC Day is about remembering sacrifice for others, and this links well with Jesus' death on the cross.



The name "ANZAC biscuits" first appeared in 1915 in a cookbook published by St Andrew's Presbyterian Church Dunedin. The biscuits were sent to the soldiers in World War One. We are continuing the tradition of the Church's service to others.

An apple tree to share and commemorate

This morning we will be blessing a dwarf apple tree which will be donated to the people of Auckland City. At this stage it most likely will be placed in Griffith Gardens in Albert St. There will be a plaque commemorating the 500th anniversary of the Reformation and 125 anniversary of the decision by the Presbyterian Church to begin a mission to Chinese in Auckland. The tree will be called hope.
