

## Do your Shopping with Foodbank in mind

Here's some ideas for what to buy for the Auckland City Mission Foodbank:

- 420g Cans of Spaghetti
- 400g Cans of Tomatoes
- 420g Canned Soup
- 420g Cans of Baked Beans
- 1 Litre UHT Milk
- 410g Canned Fruit



Many people obey God in the big issues, but they aren't aware that obedience in the little things makes a difference in His plan for their lives. The Bible says plainly that if we are not faithful in the little things, we will never be made rulers over much (see Luke 16:10). There is no reason for God to trust us with a major responsibility if we are not going to be faithful to do the little things He has asked us to do. I strongly urge you to be obedient to God even in the

smallest of things. A sixteenth-century monk called Brother Lawrence was well known

for walking continually in the presence of God. He said that He was pleased to pick up a piece of trash from the ground in obedience to God and because He loved Him.

In the verse for today, God says He will make known His words to us if we listen to Him when He corrects us. If we follow His guidance and are pleased to do each little thing He asks of us then He will open His wisdom to us, and we will have more revelation than we could ever imagine.
