

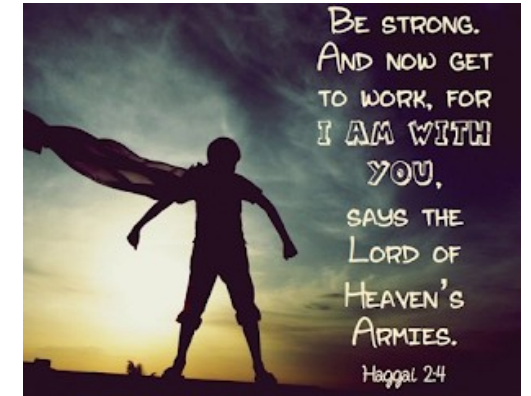

2020 Vision: Shining in the City 3: Get back to work! (Haggai 1:1-6,12-2:9)

The Rebuke

- There has been 16 years of no work on the temple.
- God's response: 'Is it a time for you yourselves to be living in your panelled houses, while this house remains a ruin?'
- "Give careful thought to your ways" (See also James 4:13-14)
- Meagre returns (1:6)

The Response (1:14)

How does this apply to us today?

- We have bought into the secular consumerist myth
- The reality is not living up to the hype
- We must consider our ways and recommit ourselves to the Lord

The Glory

- "Is that all there is?" (Ezra 3:12, Haggai 2:3)
- God's promise: "The glory of this present house will be greater than the glory of the former house ..." (2:9)

Questions to ponder

1. How do your priorities match up with God's?
2. How is God shaping your character at the moment?
3. Andrew talked about the "secular consumerist myth" being a big issue for us to consider today? How can we follow a different path?
