


The Power of the Spirit



The Power of the Spirit

- **The Spirit-empowered life**
 - *“Jesus, take the wheel”*
 - *“Give me gas in my tank, keep me driving.”*
 - *“Thy word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path.”*
 - God Spirit empowers us and guides us through God’s Word but we do the driving.



The Story of the Son



- What do you learn about Jesus in Peter's sermon?
- This is the gospel message!
- Invite a friend to read the Bible with you
- The Swedish questions:
 - What do you notice?
 - What questions do you have?
 - What action point is there to take?

The Story of the Son

- Notice the use of Scripture in Peter's message
- Principle: Know your audience so you can connect with them and adapt your message to suit their culture and understanding
- God's sovereignty in Peter's preaching. Peter makes it clear that it was God's plan from the beginning




The Growth of the Church



- The people were cut to the heart and said to Peter and the other apostles, “Brothers, what shall we do?” (37)
- Peter calls on them to repent and be baptised
- Baptism - ACPC101

The Growth of the Church

- Peter's confession and Jesus' response - Matthew 16:13-20
- Peter's epic fail, his restoration and transformation
- As a result of this message, 3000 people believe and the church is underway.



The Growth of the Church

Acts	2:1-47	3:1-26	8:26-39	10:1-48	13:14-52	14:6-20	17:16-34
Response to the message	3000 added (41)	Leaders are disturbed and arrest Peter and John and try them (4:1-3, 5-22); Many believe, and the number grows to 5000 (4:4)	A request to be baptized (36); He goes on his way rejoicing (39)	Holy Spirit comes on all who heard; speaking in tongues (44-46); Jewish believers astonished (45)	Invited to speak again (42); Some follow and talk (43); A big crowd next time but Jews oppose (44-45); Gentile converts (48);	Jews from nearby towns win over the crowd. Paul stoned, presumed dead and dragged out of city (19)	Some sneer at resurrection (32); Some want to hear more (32); Few believe (34)
